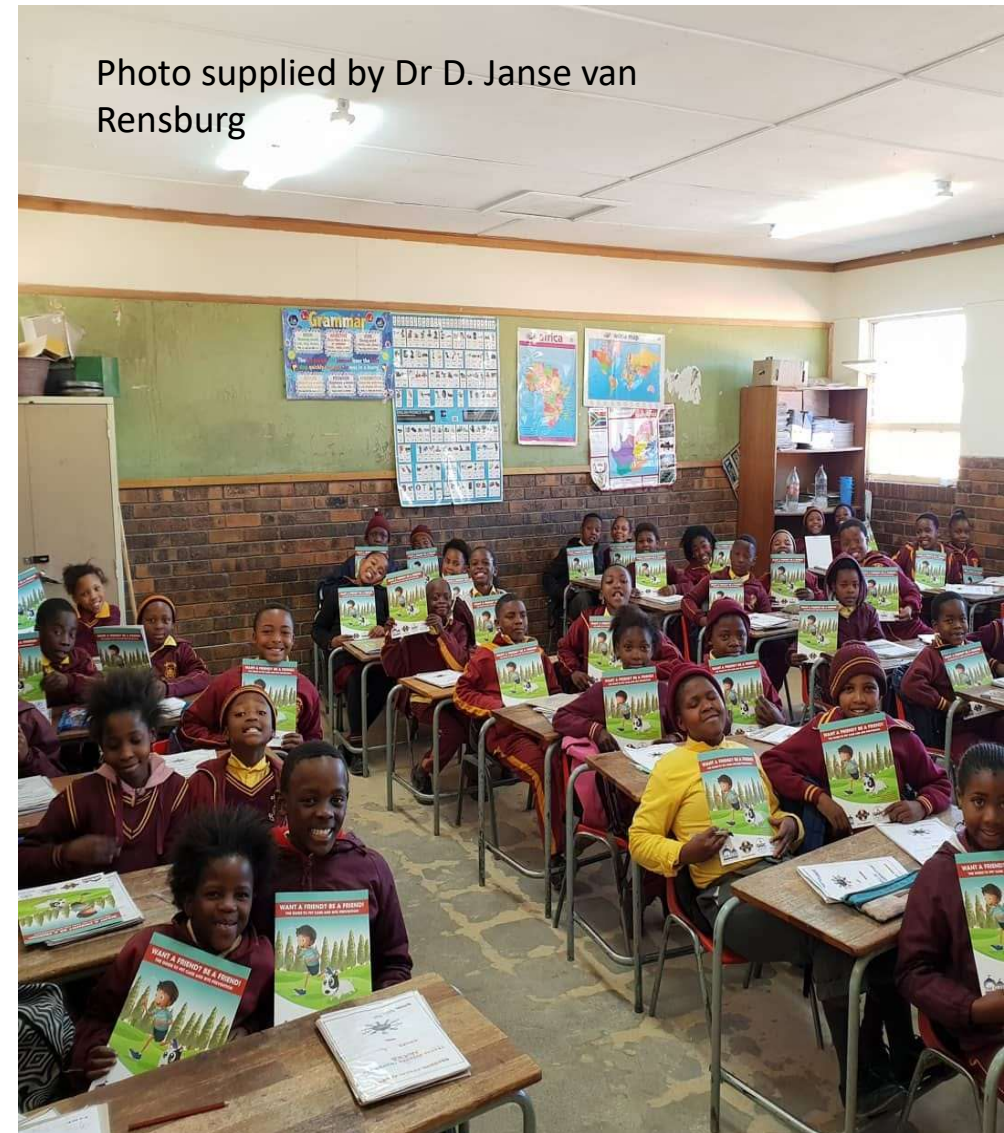

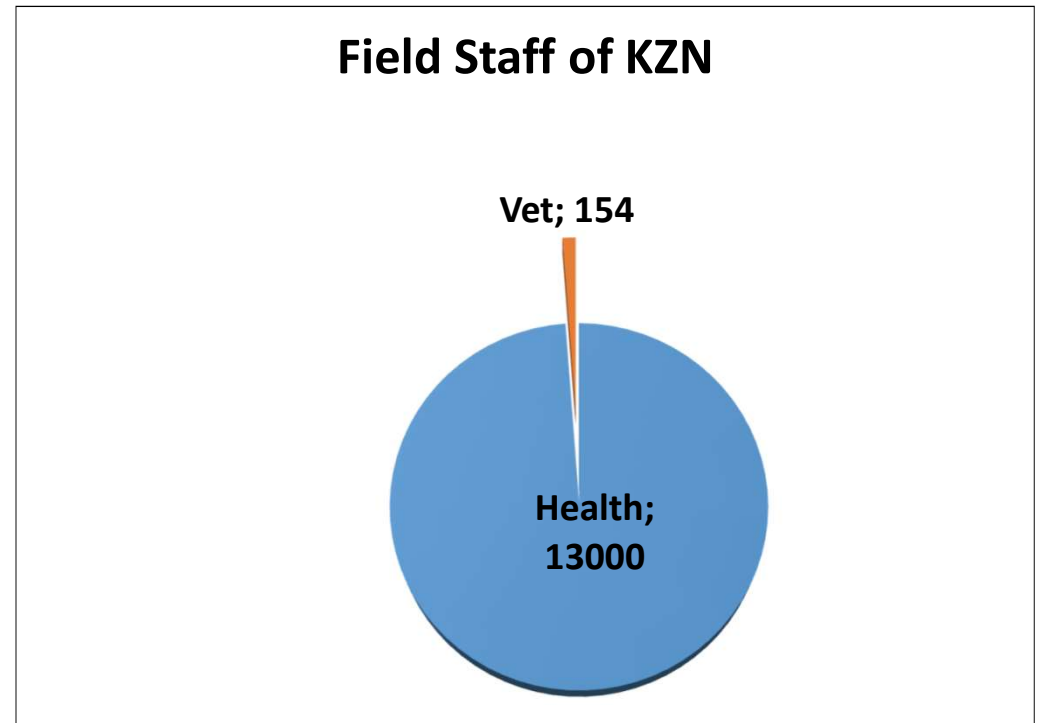
# **Education and awareness is fundamental!**

# Recognising the uniqueness of each country area etc:

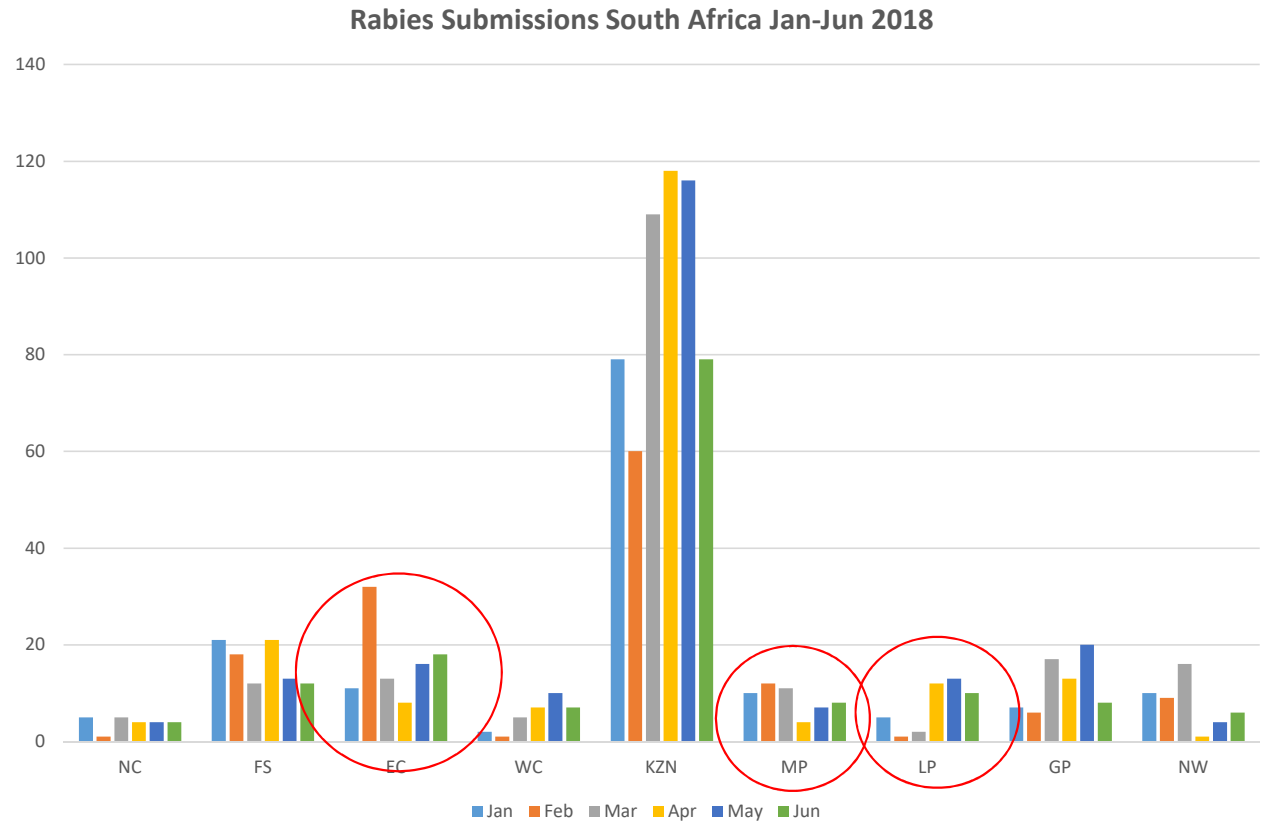
- Multiple layers of education and awareness opportunities.
