

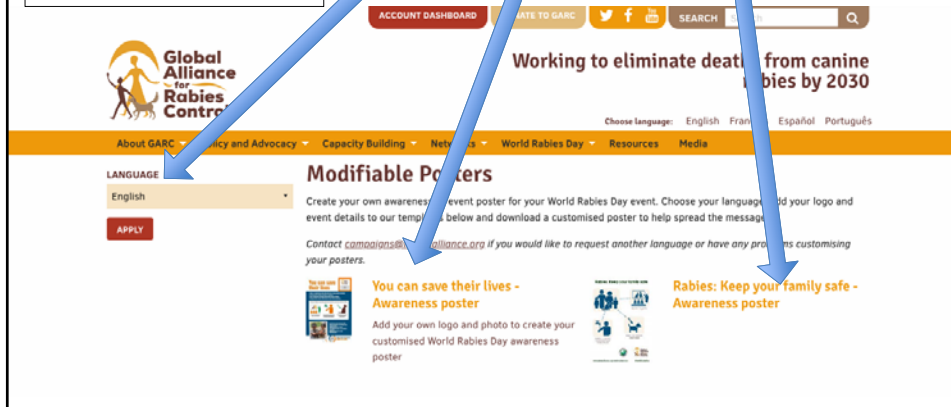

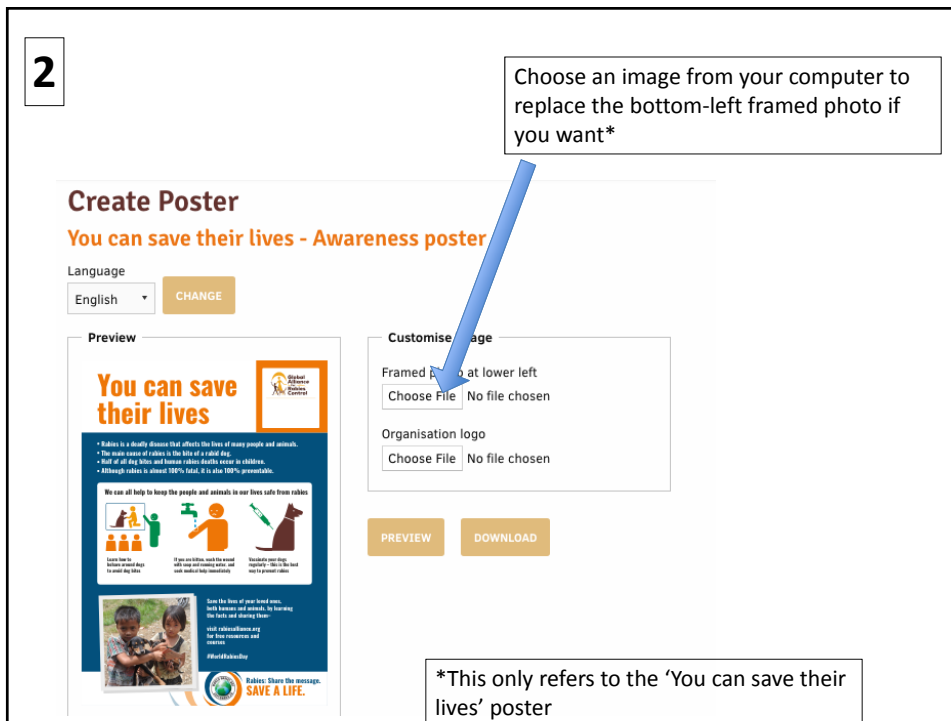
Select the language that you want your poster in and then select the poster you want to make

- The main cause of rabies is the bite of a rabid dog.
- Half of all dog bites and human rabies deaths occur in children.
- Although rabies is almost 100% fatal, it is also 100% preventable.

If you are bitten, wash the wound with soap and running water, and seek medical help immediately
